

2024 "TIGGES FARM" FALL FARM DAYS



Dear Adult Care Group Leader,

Would your group like to visit a real farm and harvest their own pumpkin? We are open Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, 10am - 6pm, starting August 8th. If so, **Tigges Farm**, 5 miles east of Windsor and 8 miles west of Greeley, is the perfect place for a field trip. An added feature is we have an "**Antique Farm Equipment Walking Museum**" and a "**Barn Quilt Gallery**" at the farm.

Fifteen acres of pumpkin patches open the end of September and they are various colors of pumpkins in the patch. We will give your group small baskets to take with them to hunt for pumpkins that fit in the basket to get the prices we state below. We also have wagons, so they don't have to carry the basket all the way from the field. A group leader can pull the wagon. We recommend you bring a marking pen and write their names on the bottom of the pumpkin before loading back up. No mix ups when you return home.

SCHEDULING: You are welcome to bring groups Thursday, Friday, Saturday or Sunday between 10am - 6pm. There is a gift shop on site with things that can be purchased as priced. Or they can do the scavenger hunt. Just copy the pages attached and bring with you along with a pencil.

We always appreciate it when group visits are pre-scheduled. Give us a call at least a day ahead of time, if possible:

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE: We have a certified handicapped public restroom on site and all buildings are wheel chair accessible. If assistance is needed to go out into the pumpkin patch, we have golf carts available that can be borrowed.

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING: The address is 12404 WCR 64 ½. Greeley, CO 80550. Directions and Map on website: www.TiggesFarmLLC.com Click the road sign on the website for directions. Buses, vans and cars should use the entrance you determine is easiest to turn bus or van into the parking lot area. If you end up going past the produce stand, just stop at the stand and let everyone off. If it has just rained, make sure you stay on the graveled parking area.
